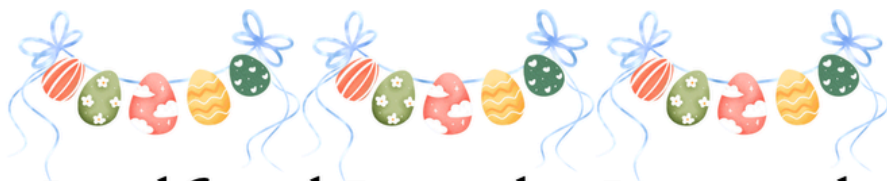

The Parish Council had arranged for National Grid to come and talk to the residents at the Scalford Parish Council meeting that took place on the 16th of March. However, following the meeting at Grimston PC in January, the National Grid decided they did not want to stand up and face the public again, which in my opinion is a serious dereliction of duty on their part considering what they are proposing to do to the landscape south of the village. Not to be deterred, myself and Ed Smiley-Jones met with the NG team and now have a formal line into the organisation which we are using to direct queries and questions. We want to hold them to account and to respond with meaningful answers to all questions so if you do have any questions that you wish to raise then please forward them to my email address cllr.sibree@scalford-pc.gov.uk and I will ensure that they are raised and responses received. The proposed power line project will remain as an agenda item at the monthly Parish Council meetings for the foreseeable future in order to keep the community informed. The meetings take place normally on the third Monday of each month in the village hall at 1900, anyone is welcome to come along and we welcome audience participation and involvement in our discussions.

Letter from the Rector

The foolishness of God?

Dear friends,

On the first day of this month, before 12 noon, many people play an April Fools' prank on their family or friends. I have to confess that I have fallen for a few pranks over the years! Although we don't know the origin of April Fools' Day, some have suggested that there is a connection between April Fools' Day (also known as All Fools' Day) and Good Friday, and that the very first Good Friday was on 1st April.

Whether or not that is true, the events of the first Holy Week can certainly seem to be utterly foolish by the standards of our own day and age - just as they were at the time. In our anxious and fearful world where many powerful leaders are authoritarian, ruthless and self-seeking, Jesus comes to us in peace, riding into Jerusalem on the back of a donkey.

He comes in humility, washing the dusty smelly feet of His followers. He comes in obedience, allowing Himself to be betrayed, arrested, condemned and crucified on that first Good Friday. Yet on Easter Day, Jesus was raised to new life by God, and His first friends and followers were witnesses to this event. In the light of Easter, they came to see how God's power and wisdom were wonderfully at work in Jesus.

What seemed utterly foolish from a human perspective was in fact God's ultimate wisdom. And so the message of the cross of Jesus Christ - His death and resurrection - have been at the heart of the Christian faith ever since. As the Apostle Paul would later put it in his letter to the Church at Corinth:

"The message about the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God ... Has not God made foolish the wisdom of the world? For since, in the wisdom of God, the world did not know God through wisdom, God decided, through the foolishness of our proclamation, to save those who believe. For Jews demand signs and Greeks desire wisdom, but we proclaim Christ crucified ... Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God. For God's foolishness is wiser than human wisdom, and God's weakness is stronger than human strength" (1 Corinthians 1. 18, 20-25).

Wishing you every joy and blessing in the light of Jesus Christ, God's Easter wisdom,

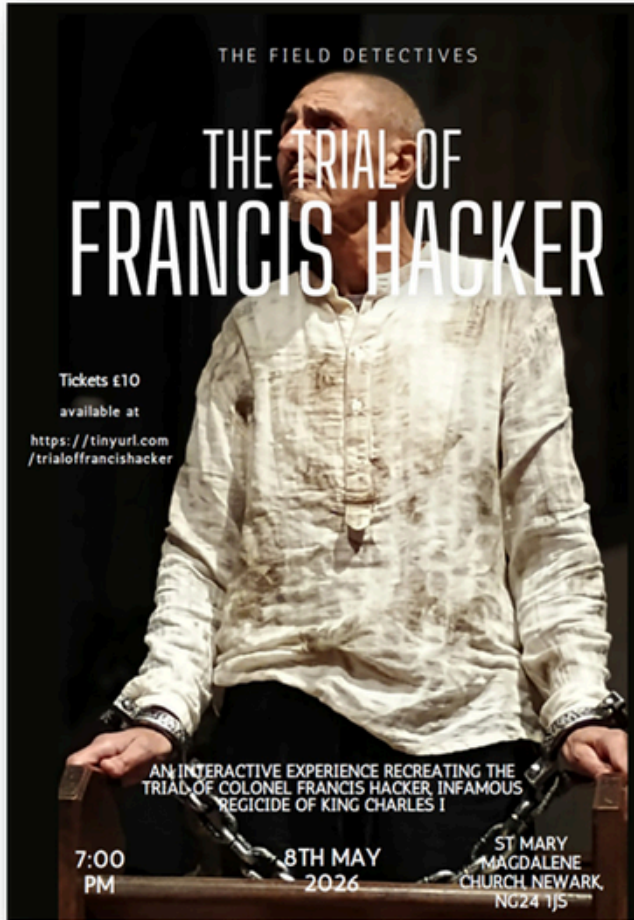

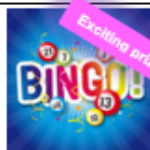
